#### PAPER SUBMISSION

PAPERS WILL BE PUBLISHED BY GAMA

#### SUBMISSION FORMAT:

1. Papers should be sent only by email.
2. All texts should be typed in Arial 11 points and single spaced. Side margins should be 2.5 cm; top and bottom margins should be 2.0 cm.
3. Do not include page numbers.
4. Illustrations and all visual data must be on the text and submitted separately using Joint Photographic Experts Group Format (JPEG) or Tagged Image File Format (TIFF) either; please be sure to format all illustrations in B&W.
5. Each file must be called with the name of the first author followed by the indication of the kind of file, i.e:

Fossataro\_Text.doc and Fossataro\_figs.doc 6. At the beginning of any paper remember to indicate:

Title

Author's name

Institutional Affiliation (Name of university, city, country, department)

Citation

Use author/date style parenthetical documentation (Harvard System) only.

If a book has only one author: (Jones, 1995)

Two or three authors: (Zipursky and Jones, 1997)

More than three authors: (Zipursky, et al., 1997)

Works by the same author published in the same year should be indicated by 'a', 'b', etc. and should follow date without

intervening space, e.g. Edwards, 1982a.

Do not use Ibid., op. cit. or similar expressions.

Bibliography

1. Grouped in author-alphabetical order at the end of the article.

2. Page numbers are elided as far as possible, e.g. 223-71 rather than 223-271; 453-9 rather than 453-459, except for numbers 11-19, e.g. 312-17 not 312-7.

3. Page numbers are required within the reference for articles in journals and separate articles in books, e.g. do not write 37ff.

Books with only one author/editor:

Mohr, L.B., 1996, Impact analysis for program evaluation. 2nd ed. London, Sage.

Book with two authors/editors:

Monograph in a series:

Karali, L., 1999, Shells in Aegean Prehistory, British Archaeological Reports, International Series, 761, Oxford, Archaeopress.

Article in journal:

Dorner, J., 1999, Die Topographie von Piramesse-Vorbericht. Egypt and the Levant, 9, 77-83.

Article in an edited book:

McGovern, P.E. and R.H. Michel., 1990, Royal purple dye: its identification by complementary physicochemical techniques. IN: Briars, W.R. and P.E. McGovern (eds.), Organic contents of ancient vessels. CD-ROMs

If using a CD-ROM to obtain a journal reference, cite the journal rather than the CD-ROM:

Royal Institute of British Architects, 1998, *Architecture and Design Illustrated*. London, RIBA [Multi-Media CD-ROM]

If the information is only available as a computer database:

Gray, J.M. and Courtney, G., 1988, *Youth cohort study* [computer file]. Colchester: Economic and Social Research Council, Data Archive [distributor]

#### OTHER DETAILS

##### Paragraph layout

Text should be justified and each paragraph should be separated with a line space. Use return/enter button to make this line

space NOT paragraph formatting.

There should only be one space between a full stop and the next word, not two as is commonly found in formal typed text.

**Sub-headings** Please use bold, bold italic and italic for subheadings. Never use underlining.

##### Bibliography

Preferred layout:

Book –

Boardman, J., 2001, *The history of Greek Vases: potters, painters and pictures*, Thames & Hudson, London

Paper in a book –

Henig, M., 2006, 'The Language of Love in Roman Britain: jewellery and the emotions' in M. Henig (ed.) *Roman Art, Religion and Society*, BAR S1577, Oxford, London

Paper in a journal –

Johns, C. et al., 1999, 'A mid-fifth century hoard of Roman and Pseudo-Roman material from Patching, West Sussex', *Britannia* 30, pp. 301-315

Where *Ibid.* and *et al.* (do not use *et alii.*) are used they should be italicised.

##### Dates

Years should NEVER have an apostrophe, i.e. 1960s, 450s NOT 1960's 450's. This is a common mistake and worth emphasizing to authors.

Choose either B.C. and A.D. or BC and AD and be consistent.

BC goes after the date, AD before, when talking about a specific date, i.e. 440 BC and AD 500

When talking about millennia or centuries, BC and AD follow the date, i.e. 5th century BC, 1st millennium AD

If the date is approximate please use c. with a space between the c. and the date, i.e. c. 500 BC

When using numerals to indicate 5th, 2nd, 3rd etc, the letters can be superscript (5<sup>th</sup>) or not – choose one style and be consistent.

Please note word will often automatically convert these to superscript, this function can be turned off, or else each occurrence must be checked and changed back to regular script.
