How to come

The Symposium will be held in the amazing **Castle of Santa Severa**, on the Tyrrhenian Sea, 60 km North of Rome.

There is a train connection from Rome Central Station (Roma Termini) every hour: it takes only 58 minutes and the price is 4,10 eur (one way). First train departs at 5:26; last train departs at 23:27.

If you arrive by plane at Rome Fiumicino, there is a train every hour to Rome Trastevere, where you will find your connection to Santa Severa: it will take 1 hour and 35 min., and it will be 11 eur.
